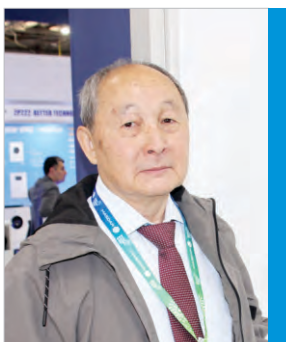
# VISITORS' REVIEWS

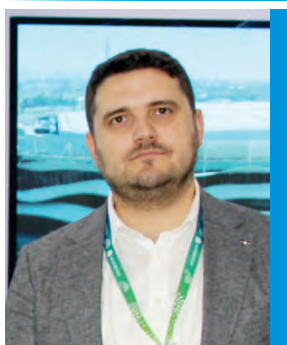

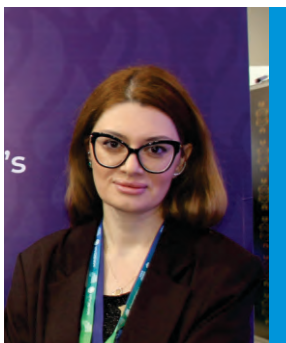

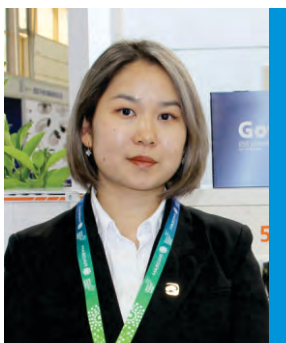
